2. Course Description

This course is designed for students who are learning Korean for the first time. The goal of this course is to learn various practical expressions based on a basic understanding of Korean grammar and communication skills. Students will learn practical Korean expressions needed in daily life, such as shopping in a store and making reservations.

3. Course Objectives

By the end of this course, students will be able to:

- Read and write Hangeul fluently.
- Engage in basic conversations in Korean with natural, though slightly slow, intonation.
- Establish a strong foundation in basic Korean grammar and vocabulary.

4. Course Methodology

1) Textbook and class: In this course, students will begin by learning the Korean alphabet, Hangeul. Through learning Hangeul, students will also acquire Korean pronunciation and intonation. The first chapter of the textbook introduces essential vocabulary that must be learned in each lesson. Students will memorize basic vocabulary and study fundamental grammar. It is recommended to review the textbook briefly before coming to class.

2) Exam

- This semester will include quizzes, a midterm exam, and a final exam. Details about the exams will be provided approximately two weeks in advance. There will be a brief

review session before both the midterm and final exams. The midterm and final exams will be in written format(Speaking assessment may be included.) and will assess the grammar and vocabulary covered in the course. Please note that there will be no make-up exams; however, make-up exams may be considered only in cases of school-recognized reasons such as illness.

- The midterm and final exams will take place in the 8th and 16th weeks, respectively. These exams will include speaking and writing components, with review sessions and exam briefings provided beforehand. The exams will assess pronunciation, vocabulary, grammar, and other language skills.
- 3) Assignments: There will be writing assignments, and deadlines must be strictly adhered to. Assignments should be submitted according to the format provided by the instructor. Late submissions may result in a reduction in points.
- 4) Presentation: The presentation will be on the same topic as the writing assignment. It will be an individual presentation, with detailed instructions provided two weeks before the presentation date.
